WHITE GLASS

- Colourless bottles (glass)
- Colourless glass bottles (disposable)
- Colourless preserves jars
- Colourless cosmetics packaging and bottles (glass)
- Colourless jam jars
- Other glass jars



Please ONLY put white glass in the white glass container. Just one green bottle is enough to turn 500kg of glass green.



STAINED GLASS

- Stained glass
- Coloured bottles (glass)
- Coloured glass bottles (disposable)
- Coloured preserves jars
- Coloured cosmetics packaging and bottles (glass)
- Coloured medicines bottles



Please ONLY put coloured glass in the coloured glass container. White glass that is wrongly disposed of bleaches coloured glass, which then cannot be used to make bottles that protect medicines from light, for example.

- Branches
- Banana skins
- Pruning waste (shredded)
- Flower remains
- Eggshells
- Food waste
- Windfall
- Meat leftovers
- Garden waste
- Vegetable waste
- Grass cuttings
- Hedge trimmings
- Coffee filters (with grounds), coffee grounds
- Bones
- Kitchen waste
- Leaves
- Food residue (spoiled, animal-based)
- Fruit and vegetable waste
- Orange peels
- Lawn cuttings
- Sticks (shredded)
- Bark

- Hedge trimmings

- Buckets (household buckets, no packaging)
- Disposable tableware (plastic)
- Paint residues (cured, solvent-free)
- Photos
- Watering cans
- Glassware (e.g. glasses)
- Lightbulbs (excluding energy saving bulbs)
- Hair, household sweepings
- Domestic animal faeces
- Hygiene products (used)
- Cat litter, bones
- Ballpoint pens
- Kitchen roll (soiled)
- Paper towels (heavily soiled)
- Tissues (used)
- Plastic toys



METAL PACKAGING*

- Aluminium cans
- Aluminium foil
- Aluminium tubes
- Aluminium fasteners
- Tin cans, completely empty (e.g. tinned fruit, paint cans)
- Cans, empty (aluminium and tin)
- Paint cans (brush clean)
- Drinks cans
- Yoghurt pot lids
- Tin cans
- Metal tubes (empty)
- Metal packaging (empty)
- Metal fasteners
